## Company Profile

JPA is a regulatory body overseeing the operations of the ports of Pasir Gudang and Tanjung Pelepas in Gelang Patah.

As a regulatory body, the JPA has the following functions:

- To ensure that port operations are conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations.
- To control the tariffs imposed by port operators on all users of the ports.
- To control of all development and landholding affairs, and ensuring port operators undertake any port development in accordance with the port master plan and national development policy.
- To set performance standards so as to ensure port operators provide efficient and effective services and facilities in accordance with international standards.
- To maintain the security of the waters within the Johor Port limit, especially from the threat of piracy and smuggling.
- To facilitate commerce by holding promotions on behalf of port operators through participation in exhibitions and trade visits.
- JPA is also responsible for the issuance of licenses for services such as private jetties, support services, pilotage, in relation to port users and in relation to licensed operators
