## **Company Profile**

The Ministry of Transport (MOT) was established in 1956 and became known as the Ministry of Communications in 1972. After going through several merges, in 1978 the Ministry was renamed the Ministry of Transport until now. The MOT is responsible for planning, formulating and implementing transport policies and infrastructure projects for rail, maritime, ports and civil aviation. In addition, the MOT is also responsible for the registration of all modes of vehicles, determine pricing policy (except for commercial vehicle road), regulating the policies and operations of the concessionaire/government companies and verification/regulate the standards of service, safety (service and safety standards) and legal. In addition, the MOT is also responsible for coordinating the integration between transport modes to achieve seamless travel and provide licensing services as follows:

- I. License/permit the operation of the service provider and the holder of the concession (except commercial vehicle road)
- II. Individual licence-private/commercial vehicle drivers, pilot, pilot, pilot and others
- III. Domestic shipping license
